- 30 **CANDIDATO BLANCO** – Spain £14.95  
Fruity notes of green apples, grapefruit and quince as well as strong floral notes and hints of fresh breadcrumbs. Silky and smooth with well-balanced flavours and a long finish. 11.5% vol.

- 31 **ARESTI ESTATES GEWURTZRAMINER** – Chile £18.95  
Vibrant, pale, yellow in colour. The wine has a truly varietal nose showing intense aromas of lychee and red rose petals. On the palate it displays intense aromatic and floral notes. 13.5% vol.

- 32 **ARDESIA PINOT GRIGIO IGT** – Italy £19.95  
Light straw colour. Fine, elegant, clean and intense aroma. Dry to taste with a pleasant green apple aftertaste. A lively and easy to drink wine. 12% vol.

- 33 **ARESTI ESTATES CHARDONNAY** – Chile £16.95  
The bouquet displays creamy, vanilla aromas that complement the citrus and pear notes on the palate. Soft and sweet with an excellent balance. A very pleasant, refreshing and approachable wine. 13.5% vol.

- 34 **ARESTI SAUVIGNON BLANC** – Chile £17.85  
The grapes were hand harvested from three different vineyards. Cold fermentation temperatures were maintained at 15-16° to protect the fresh and fruity characters. 13.5% vol.

- 35 **SOLAGUEN RIOJA BLANCO** – Spain £21.95  
Medium pale in colour. Dry and fresh, fruit bouquet with hints of apple and citrus. A pleasant and long length. 13.5% vol.
- 36 **MIOLO RESERVA CHARDONNAY 2008 – BRAZIL** £21.95  
Light golden colour, citrus aroma with hints of toasty oak, textured, fresh, acacia hints and beautifully integrated oak. 13% vol.
- 37 **QUINTA DE SAES BRANCO 2007 DAO** – Portugal £21.95  
(Encruzado, Cercial and Malvasia)  
Light, balanced and citrusy. Pale in colour but big on the nose. Green fruit and limes blend harmoniously to give this wine a lightness to enjoy. 12.5% vol.
- 38 **SAUVIGNON BLANC NAUTILUS ESTATE** – New Zeland £23.80  
Aromas of gooseberries and lime give way to an intense palate of melon, passionfruit and citrus flavours. 13.5% vol.

- 39 **ATILIO AVENA OAK AGED CHARDONNAY** – Argentina £23.80  
Golden colour with light shades of green. The nose is rich and fully flavoured, with vibrant citrus fruit. On the palate it displays freshness, some hints of vanilla and a well balanced acidity. 13% vol.
- 40 **MARCEL HUGG RIESLING** – France £25.55  
Fresh and expressive on the nose with pure citrus fruit and hints of honey. Fruity and delicate on the palate with a bone dry finish. 12% vol.
- 41 **DOMAINE CUROT SANCERRE AOC** - France £27.95  
Dry, fruity and mineral on the nose with particular notes of citrus fruits. Notes of tropical fruit on the palate such as peach, mango and ripe apricot. 13% vol.
- 42 **LUCIEN TARDIEU CHABLIS AOC** – France £29.50  
Lucien Tardieu Chablis is crisp and refreshing with wonderful ripe fruit aromas of summer flowers and the distinctive mineral character of great Chablis. 12.5% vol.
- 43 **ST MICHELE APPIANO CRU SANCT VALENTIN SAUVIGNON BLANC**– Italy £34.50  
Light green in colour with wild elderflower, figs and gentle spices on the nose. Fine, dry and balanced with a long lasting palate. 14% vol.  
*The flagship wine of the St Mary winery. This wine has won many international accolades. In particular from the Gambero Rosso who has awarded this wine Tre Bicchieri for 13 consecutive vintages. Typical Sauvignon Blanc characteristics just jump out the glass!*
